# S6C (SALISBURY 6TH FORM COLLEGE)


Over the coming months our Careers Team will be visiting Post-16 providers and each time they do, we will bring you the most up-to-date and behind the scenes photos to give you a real feel for each sixth form or college.

This week, the wet and windy weather was completely forgotten when the Careers Team received a warm and friendly welcome to <u>S6C (Salisbury 6th Form College)</u>. Ben Hillier (Head of College) and Teresa Salmon (Admissions Officer) took them on a wonderful tour of the modern building which houses 455 students all achieving their next steps through Level 3 study.

There are 32 Level 3 courses for students to choose from, including both A Levels and vocational qualifications. New courses such as Early Childhood Development, Criminology and Sustainability have been introduced, so there really is something for everyone. S6C has a strong "university vibe" with independent study spaces, use of a gym with no cost to students and a bustling café open all day.

S6C prides itself on delivering high quality teaching from subject specialists which enables students to achieve the best outcomes and progress in the local area. Their "it's all about you" tag-line is realised in the way that students are treated and known as individuals; it was lovely to see Ben greet each student we passed by name and they equally were happy to talk to him. This added to the strong family-feel that really came across during the visit where knowledge of each student helps teachers to understand and care about each student's career aspirations and tailor their programme to help them achieve those goals. It was also great to see so many Trafalgar Alumni.
