New government figures show that apprenticeship starts in England were up 7% in the first quarter of 2023/24 compared to the same period last year.

Provisional in-year data reports 130,830 starts in August, September and October of 2023, up from 122,290 for the same period the year before.

# POMPEY IN THE COMMUNITY FOOTBALL AND EDUCATION PROGRAMME





Today students from Year 9, 10 & 11 who are interested in a future in Sport were invited to attend an assembly hosted by Pompey in the Community. Pompey in the Community offer a 2 year BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in Sport - an alternative football-focused experience to college. It is suitable for male and female students who are keen to develop an insight into opportunities within the sports industry. After completing the BTEC, you will also have the option of training for a further year to gain a Level 3 Diploma in Personal Training.

Alongside your academic studies, you will hone your football skills by training with fully qualified FA and UEFA coaches twice a week on a 3G surface. You will also have the opportunity to play for Pompey in the Community against other professional clubs in the National Football Youth League. National and international trips are also an integral part, with Pompey providing the chance to visit world-famous stadiums and high-profile organisations.

However, this course is not just for those who wish to pursue a professional career in football. The course covers units such as Sport Psychology, Anatomy & Physiology and Officiating. This means that it can also lead to careers in Sport Business, Elite Performance, Health & Fitness, Community & Education and Media & Broadcasting. You could become anything from a personal trainer to a sport journalist!

There are no tuition fees, but there is a £200 cost for your full training kit. Entry requirements are 5 GCSEs, including a Grade 4 or above in English and Maths.
