There will be a short welcome presentation which will take place at 5.30pm and repeated at 6.30pm by Ben Hillier, Head of College.

S6C hosted a Careers Assembly here at Trafalgar in September, and we found out that S6C is a college where "it's all about you!" There are only 450 students, which allows everyone to know everyone and your teachers will know you as a person. They will know your subjects, your careers aspirations and support you to achieve them.

This year S6C was oversubscribed in English Literature, Law, Maths and Geography and almost at maximum capacity in Psychology, Media, Sport, Business and Creative Media. Their advice is to apply as early as you can!

Applications for S6C opened on Sunday 1st October 2023 and the deadline for applications is Wednesday 31st January 2024. However, the first round of student interviews starts next month, so get your application in as soon as possible to be considered for a place.
