### BROCKENHURST COLLEGE

Over the coming months our Careers Team will be visiting Post-16 providers and each time they do, we will bring you the most up-to-date and behind the scenes photos to give you a real feel for each sixth form or college.

The wet weather this week didn't get in the way of the Careers Team's tour of Brockenhurst College's amazing 36-acre modern campus, which is located in the New Forest National Park. The college has the widest range of A Level, Vocational and Apprenticeship programmes available locally with 3000 students choosing to start their further education journey with them.

As a large college you might expect the campus to be busy and noisy, but everywhere the team went during the visit, students were calm and quiet and purposeful. Brockenhurst College would be an excellent choice to 'bridge-the-gap' between school and university as it offers a university-feel with self-directed study, over 35 clubs and societies to take part in and a large campus, but crucially, without being overwhelming.

The weather during the visit did not give the best opportunity to view the wonderful green spaces, however they are plentiful and adjoin their incredible sporting facilities including 25-acres of playing fields, a fully equipped gym and fitness studio and plenty of all-weather courts for netball and tennis. There are also lovely social spaces including 'The Hub' as the Learning Resource Centre with bookable project working spaces and 2 eateries where in the café space students can learn barista skills.
