Main Purpose

- Maintain workshop tools, equipment, and machinery; report or carry out repairs as needed
- Attend department meetings and technician training
- Support extra-curricular projects without compromising core curriculum needs
- Uphold Health & Safety, COSHH, Child Protection, and Safeguarding standards
- Support exhibitions and events when required
- Work collaboratively with staff and contribute to a positive school environment
- Act as an ambassador for the school, modelling Trafalgar's values and ethos contributing to a respectful and inclusive culture
